



LOCAL RULE

OUT OF BOUNDS - SWALE

Background

Anywhere beyond the reed line on the western side (opposite to the Golf Course) of the swale is deemed to be out of bounds.

A ball landing in the water is deemed to be in the water hazard as defined by the red stacks.

Local Rule – Out of Bounds

A player whose ball lies beyond the reed line on the western side of the swale is required to replay his/her ball from the previous position and will incur a one stroke penalty.
